**SUMMARY:** Hill Country High School helps nontraditional students earn a high school diploma and prepare for postsecondary pursuits.

**GOAL:** Increase the number of students attending post-secondary educational opportunities after graduation. During the 2018-2019 school year, HCHS received 86 requests for records from former students.

**ACTIVITIES:** Prepare students for the TSI by providing intense remediation on Algebra II skills and utilizing APEX on-line tutoring program, take field trips to local colleges and universities, and assist students with FAFSA application process.

## POSTSECONDARY SUCCESS

**SUMMARY:** Enhance our focus on student post-graduation success through collaborating with local employers. Provide opportunities on campus and through field trips for students to interact with professionals and educators in pathways that are projected to grow and that offer gainful employment prospects. Our local partners include Peterson Regional Medical Center, All-Plastics, and Alamo Colleges, and Texas State Technical College.

**GOAL:** Increase the number of students who begin post-graduation education, training, or military enlistment within one semester of graduation.

**ACTIVITIES:** Field trips to career sites, as well as career prep and education institutions; guest speakers, individual guided student research regarding career interests, training needed, funding, and location of training.
